GEORGE C. PASSMORE, a successful farmer and representative citizen of Penn township, where he owns 305 acres of excellent land, which lies two and one-fourth miles southeast of Grampian, Pa., was born in the Bailey settlement, in Pike township, Clearfield county, August 11, 1830, and is a son of Ganer (*Gainer*) and Mary Elizabeth (McCracken) Passmore.

Ganer (*Gainer*) Passmore was born on the same farm in Pike township which was the birthplace of his son, his father, Abraham Passmore, having been a pioneer settler there. Ganer (*Gainer*) Passmore married Mary Elizabeth McCracken and they continued to live on the old Passmore homestead. They were members of the Methodist Episcopal church. They had five children, namely: Joseph and Hiram, both of whom are deceased; Eli; Henrietta, who lives near Madera, Pa.; and George C., of Penn township.

George C. Passmore attended school in his youth in Penn, Pike and Ferguson townships, and went to work at lumbering for some years trying his strength in making lumber and his skill in rafting it down the river. For a short time following his marriage he lived in Bell township and then settled on his present farm in Penn township, where he carries on farming and stock raising.

In 1850 Mr. Passmore was married to Miss Elizabeth Rice, who was born in Lycoming county, Pa., July 28, 1834, a daughter of William and Nancy Rice. She lost her parents in infancy. To Mr. and Mrs. Passmore five children have been born, namely: William; Allen, who is deceased; Viola, who is the wife of George Bowman, of DuBois, and they have two children - William and Lizzie; George McClelland (*McClellan*), who married Matilda Happer (*Hepfer*), a daughter of Simon Happer (*Hepfer*), and they have four children - Sherman, Berna (*Mirna/Myrna*), Olive, Helen, and Irwin, who married Maude Sankey, lives in California and they have two children. In politics Mr. Passmore is a Democrat and being a man of high standing in his neighborhood, has frequently been elected to local offices and has served acceptably as school director, treasurer, assessor and road supervisor.

Children of George C. Passmore and Elizabeth Rice

William Passmore, born about 1852, was the eldest son. He appeared in the following records:

1860 USFC – 8 years of age – resided in Bell, Clearfield, PA.

1910 USFC – 58 years of age – resided in Clearfield, Penn, PA; listed as “single.” Other residents include his parents and Sherman Passmore (William’s nephew and son of George McClelland Passmore who resided with his family next door).

1920 USFC – 69 years of age, single, born in Pennsylvania, “lodger” living in Denver, Colorado.

1925 Obituary for Viola Passmore Bowman listed brothers, Irvin and William, as “living in the West.” William was 74 years of age when Viola died.

Allen Passmore is buried in the Lumber City Cemetery, Penn Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania. Other family members buried by him are his mother, Elizabeth Rice Passmore, and his niece Lena Bowman (Viola's daughter), who died when she was 5 months old.

Note: There are some McCracken's buried in this cemetery; George C. Passmore's mother's name was McCracken.

Narrow Escape from Death

Lee Bell, an employee of the Roaring Run Quarries, is a patient in the Clearfield Memorial Hospital as the result of an accident at the Quarries, at two o'clock Saturday afternoon that nearly cost him his life.

A cave-in of rock was the cause of the injuries which consist of a broken collar-bone, four ribs broken, and a dislocated shoulder. It is not believed that he suffered internal injuries. Dr. H. O. King responded immediately and ordered the injured man to the hospital where he was removed by the Clearfield Hospital ambulance. It is not believed that he has been seriously hurt and that he will respond to treatment now that the broken bones have been set. Fellow-workers declare it a miracle that the large rock did not crush the life out of him and attribute the fact that it did not, to Bell alighting in a ditch as he fell and the boulder striking it sideways whereas had he landed on the flat ground his life would have been crushed out.

Detroit (AP)—John Lanager faces possible imprisonment on mail fraud charges because he used the mails to trace his wife.

Lanager's wife, Helen, 40, left him last April after a family quarrel. He didn't know where she went.

So Lanager, 44, filed change of address cards at the Detroit Post Office. He put on them the names of some of his wife's relatives.

Among the names were Lee A. Bell, Clearfield, Pa. and Olive Bell, Harrisburg, Pa.

Soon Lanager got a letter addressed to Bell. It was from his wife. He brought her back home.

But Bell, meantime, was disturbed about his missing mail. The post office checked and uncovered Lanager's scheme. He pleaded guilty to obtaining mail by fraud and deception.

INGENUITY UNREWARDED

DETROIT, Aug. 2. (AP)—If your wife leaves home, don't try to get her back the way John Lanager did.

He now faces possible imprisonment on mail fraud charges.

His 40-year-old wife Helen left him last April after a family spat. Lanager, who is 44, didn't know where she went. To find out, he filed change of address cards at the Detroit postoffice, putting on them the names of some of his wife's relatives.

Among the names were Lee A. Bell, of Clearfield, Pa., and Olive Bell, of Harrisburg, Pa., a son and daughter by a previous marriage.

Sure enough, Lanager got a

letter at his home addressed to Bell. It was from his unsuspecting wife in Niagara Falls. Lanager went there and brought her back.

In May, Mrs. Lanager left again. Through his system, Lanager located her in Harrisburg. He brought her back again.

By this time Bell in Clearfield was disturbed about his lack of mail. He took the matter up with the postoffice and Lanager's scheme was uncovered.

Lanager is now awaiting sentence after pleading guilty in federal court to obtaining mail by fraud and deception.
